

Seafood

Retailers are starting to lower seafood prices to be more in-line with declining alternative protein prices including beef. During September, the average retail seafood price fell .8% from the prior month, was down 1.3% from 2016 and the lowest in thirteen months. If this trend continues it could be supportive of the wholesale seafood markets during the winter.
