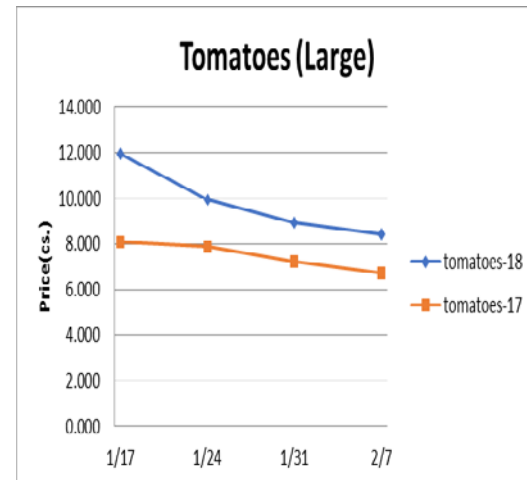


Produce

The tomato markets remain at relatively engaging levels for buyers as supplies have almost recovered from last year's hurricane. Tomato shipments from Florida last week rose 14% from the previous week and were just 7% less than the same week last year. History suggests that the downside price risk in tomatoes from here is likely only modest. Idaho potato prices have been steady to soft during the last week. However, potato stocks from last fall's harvest are below last year, and higher potato prices are likely in the coming months.
