Seafood - Elevated fuel prices and relatively low shrimp prices are helping curb U.S. shrimp landings. During July, U.S. Gulf of Mexico shrimp landings were 1.1% smaller than the prior year and the second lowest for the month in the last five years. Still, the elevated U.S. dollar value should encourage shrimp imports this fall tempering any notable upside price risk.
