Seafood - The shrimp markets continue to track below a year ago and are at historically low levels. Despite this, U.S. shrimp imports were solid in April. During the month, the U.S. brought in 6.1% more shrimp than 2018. With the elevated U.S. dollar, good shrimp imports are anticipated to persist for 2019. However, the downside risk in shrimp prices from here is likely nominal.
